### Spring is here and it's time for spring vaccinations!

We are already booking for spring visits! Spring is very busy here at HHVS and appointments fill up very fast. Be sure to plan ahead especially if you have showing or traveling deadlines.

**Equines:** Horses are due for their full series of shots including: Rabies, Flu/Rhino, EWT/WN, Strangles and Potomac Horse Fever. Most people have a Coggins done at this time as well. We highly recommend dividing your spring vaccinations into 2 or 3 visits with 2 to 3 weeks in between vaccination visits to reduce the risk of adverse reactions. Remember, there is no farm call if 8 or more horses are receiving spring vaccinations!

**Ruminant / Camelids:** Spring visits for our ruminant and camelid patients include annual exams, rabies, CD&T, deworming, hoof trimming and Vitamin E and Selenium shots.
